Indications

It is not intended to cure the causes of pain or swellings. Therefore, apply this product only when symptoms appear. (3) Do not use more than 2 sheets per day. (4) If you are sweating or the affected area gets wet, dry it off thoroughly before applying. (5) For persons with sensitive skin, cut the sheet into a 1-2 cm square and apply it to a delicate area such as the inner arm for at least half a day. Confirm that no symptoms such as rashes, redness, itching, or irritations appear before use.

Storage and Handling Precautions

(1) Store in a cool place with little humidity and out of direct sunlight. (2) Keep out of reach of children. (3) Don't put it in a different container. (It can lead to misuse or lowering of quality.) (4) To maintain product quality, store unused sheets in the bag and seal it properly. (5) Please do not use medicine after the expiration date. It is recommended to use the product shortly after opening an aluminum bag.
