Dosage and Administration

Take the following amount with cold or warm water.

|---------------------------|-----------------|--|
| Adults (15 years or over) | 3 tablets | 3 times. |
| 12 to 14 years | 2 tablets | Take within 30 minutes after a meal if possible. |
| Under 12 years | | Do not use. |

This product is a white sugar-coated tablet. Nine tablets contain the following ingredients.

Other ingredients: Cellulose, magnesium aluminometasilicate, CMC-Ca, hydroxypropyl cellulose, magnesium stearate, gum arabic, titanium oxide, stearic acid, refined sugar, talc, hypromellose, polyvinyl acetal diethyl aminoacetate, polyvinyl alcohol (partially saponified), povidone, fumaric acid, carnauba wax

- 3. Do not drive vehicles or operate machines after taking this product.

- 5. Do not drink alcohol before and after taking this product.
- 6. Do not use this product continuously for a long term.
