Precautions

X Things to avoid

(If you fail to follow these precautions, your present symptoms may worsen, or side effects may occur more readily.)

- 1. Do not use any of the following medicines while taking this medicine:
 - (1) Oral medicines which contain licorice or its main component, glycyrrhizinic acid (May cause edema, increase in blood pressure, or muscular disorders (myopathy), etc.))
- (2) Oral medicines containing tranexamic acid.
 (Oral medicines for rhinitis, cold medicines, antipyretic analgesics, antitussive and expectorant medicines, etc.)
- 2. Do not take this medicine continuously for a long term.

Things to consult

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1. Consult with a doctor, pharmacist, or registered salesclerk before taking this medicine if:

- (1) You are receiving medical or dental treatment.
- (2) You are pregnant or might be pregnant.
- (3) You are elderly.
- (4) You have experienced allergic reactions to medications before.
- (5) You are experiencing any of the following symptoms:
 - Edema
- (6) Persons who experienced any of the following diseases:

Hypertension, heart disease, kidney disease, thrombosis (cerebral thrombosis, myocardial infarction, thrombophlebitis, etc.) or you are at risk of developing thrombosis

2. If any of the following symptoms occur after taking this medicine, they may indicate side effects. Discontinue use immediately and consult with a doctor, pharmacist, or registered salesclerk with this instruction leaflet.

Stomatitis, pharyngitis/tonsillitis (throat swelling and throat pain)

Dosage and Administration

Take the following amount with water or warm water.

Under 7 years old	Do not use.	

<Precautions related to Dosage and Administration>

- (1) Strictly follow the Dosage and Administration.
- (2) Available to take either before or after meals.
- (3) Use for children aged 7 or older should be supervised by guardians.
- (4) How to take out the tablets:



As shown in the figure on the right, use your finger to push the PTP sheet that contains the tablet. Take off the aluminum foil on the back and ingest the tablet. (If you mistakenly take the tablet with the wrapping on it, it could puncture the mucous membrane of the esophagus and lead to other unknown consequences.)

Ingredients and Quantities

This product is a pale-yellow film-coated tablet, containing the following ingredients per 6 tablets.

<Precautions related to Ingredients and Quantities>

- (1) The riboflavin (Vitamin B2) contained in this product may turn the urine vellow.
- (2) Taking this product may affect the results of laboratory tests performed on the urine or feces. If you are examined by doctors, tell them that you are taking a medicine containing Vitamin C.

Storage and Handling Precautions

- (1) Store in a cool place with little humidity and out of direct sunlight.
- (2) Keep out of reach of children.
- (3) Do not transfer and keep in a different container. (It can lead to misuse or lowering of quality.)
- (4) Please do not use the product after the indicated expiration date. From the perspective of quality assurance, after opening the inner package (foil pouch). use the product within 6 months.
- (5) Write the date the inner package (foil pouch) was opened in the "Date Opened" field on the box.



Stomatitis is the general term for inflammations with small ulcers on the mouth's mucous membranes, such as inside the cheeks, tongue, and inner lips. Causes can vary from accidental bites and injuring the mucosa, imbalanced nutrition, fatigue, lack of sleep, and/or stress. The pain and stinging in the affected area often make it difficult to eat or talk.

- Make sure to eat a well-balanced diet. • Try to maintain a regular sleep schedule and lifestyle. **Stomatitis** Prevention
 - Try to manage your stress healthy and avoid overexertion.
 - Try to limit alcohol, tobacco, and stimulant foods.
 - Chew gum or eat candy to secrete saliva to keep your mouth moist.
 - Brush your teeth after eating regularly to maintain oral hygiene.
